Dear Parents, Guardians, & Students:

Quarter 3 Report Cards for the 2021-2022 school year are now available through the Parent Portal of Genesis at <http://www.hpschools.net/>. Please log in to review the teachers' comments about your student's grades for this marking period. If you need assistance logging into Genesis, please contact the High School Main Office at the phone number above.

Advanced Placement exams will be administered in person using paper-based testing for our students, as scheduled from May 2, 2022 – May 13, 2022. Students taking AP exams will be excused from participation in classroom sessions and will be allowed to hand in any work due on an exam day late without penalty, especially if a student is preparing for multiple exams on consecutive days. However, if the student only has one AP exam or has a few days between exams, they are required to attend classes that are scheduled for that day. Specific information regarding exam requirements has already been shared by Ms. Hayes, our AP Coordinator, and individual AP teachers.

Additionally, the NJSLA testing for 9th and 11th grade students will take place the week of May 23, 2022 – May 27, 2022, according to the following schedule:
