

## Free Meals Update - October 21, 2022

Good Afternoon -

As previously communicated, the [School Meals Assistance Revenue for Transition \(SMART\)](#) funds, which temporarily provides breakfast and lunch at no cost for all students during the beginning of the year, is a limited program.

**Important update** - based on new guidance released from the State of CT on October 20, the last day for free meals will be Monday, October 31. **Beginning Tuesday, November 1, 2022, students will be responsible to pay for breakfast and lunch unless they qualify for free or reduced meals;** see below for the application.

*Note - this is the 4th reminder, if you have recently filled out the application, it is being processed and no action is needed. If you are direct certified by the state (for example, you receive SNAP, TANF, or other similar benefits, no action is needed and you do not need to submit a FRL application.*
