Duke TIP is offered to 4th – 6th grade students who score at or above the 95th percentile on a grade level test. The test can be the GA Milestone, an intelligence test or any other normed test. Some students excel academically but do not test well may participate in Duke TIP by receiving an educator recommendation.

Duke TIP is an amazing way to help students understand how far their academic abilities can go. The advanced online activities offer students the opportunity to truly explore all academic areas and allow them to discover their true talents. Duke TIP can take students to the next level with the online activities and through the EXPLORE test. The EXPLORE test gives students, parents, and teachers a clearer understanding of a student's academic abilities. Students who choose to join the online book club are exposed to various academic topics such as reading, science, and engineering. Duke TIP students also have the opportunity to participate in online independent learning courses that study medicine, storytelling, and architecture just to name a few.
