## Safety Reminders

The lane to the South of the school is technically an emergency lane during school hours. While buses are there, it is a bus lane and other vehicles should not use this as an exit at that time. It is never an entrance.

We ask that you utilize the parent loops as often as possible when dropping off or picking students up (before and after school). This lane is efficient when utilized correctly. Please use the left lane to exit, and the right to pick up or drop off. Please keep moving forward in the right lane to fill spaces, and exit as soon as safely possible after picking up/dropping off your child.



## Powerschool Registration

***As a reminder:*** Students are required to be registered in PowerSchool each year prior to the beginning of the school year. This is an annual process that needs to be completed. Please ensure you review all information and update phone numbers, addresses, emails etc.... This will give us the most up to date information in case we need to contact you. As a reminder most of our communication will be through Swift Alert (texts and emails), and if we don't have your updated info, you may miss some important information. As a reminder: Emergency contacts are individuals you would like us to call after we have tried you as the parents/guardians.
