

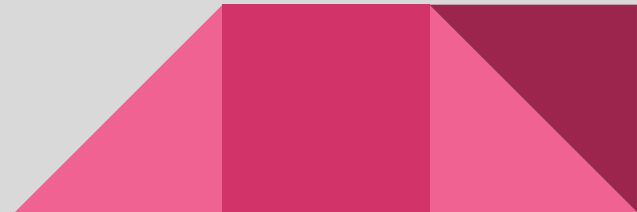
Arrival to School

Car riders - drop off in front of the school closest to handicapped parking area

Bus riders - dropped off at Community Entrance

Breakfast available 7:40 - 8:00 am

Students report directly to bus waiting area. Staggered release to 1st period class at 7:53



Dismissal from School

2 dismissal waves

- @ 2:50 pm - 1st load bus student dismiss and report to buses at Community Entrance; car riders report to main entrance for pick-up
- @ 2:50 pm - 2nd load bus student dismiss and report to auxiliary gymnasium; after school activity students report to auxiliary gym. @ctivity areas



Positive Behavior Intervention & Supports (PBIS)

Core values for CMS students are to:

Be **R**espectful to others, including students and staff

Be **R**esponsible for your actions and decisions

Be **D**etermined to give your best effort and follow-through



Threatening statements to harm

Directed towards self or others

ALL taken seriously. Must be investigated.

Not “in fun” or “joking”

Report to any teacher, counselor, principal, SRO, or school adult

Procedures to protect all students and staff



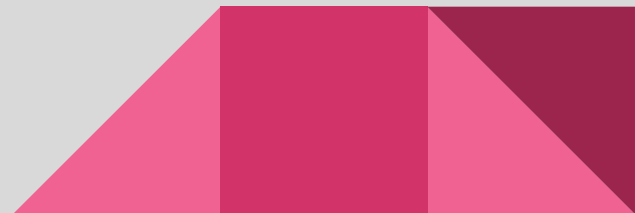
Chromebooks and Chargers

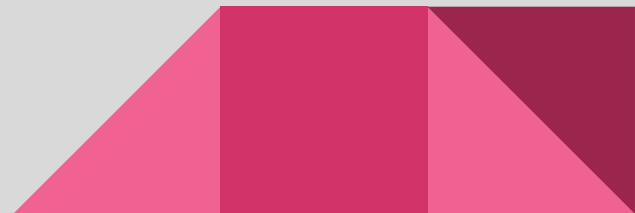
