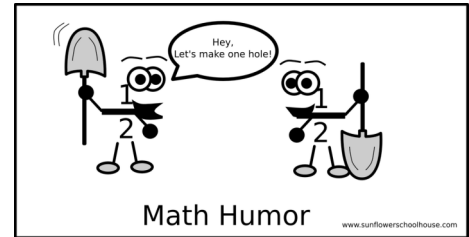


## Math: Mrs. Pleasant
